PER CURIAM. An election complaint was filed with this Court alleging irregularities regarding certain candidates whose eligibility was contested. *In Re: Spring 2005 Election Complaints Concerning Candidate Eligibility*, 2005 ASM SJ 2. This Court found that the Student Election Commission (SEC) acted improperly and that certain persons who had filed declarations were indeed improperly accepted by the SEC. *Id.* at 2-4. This Court ordered the SEC to provide lists of candidates with such discrepancies and any evidence as to why they should not be excluded. *Id.* at 5. We further retained jurisdiction to supplement our first mandate. *Id.* at 5. We now exercise that jurisdiction to specifically enjoin the placement of certain persons on the Spring 2005 ballot.

IT IS ORDERED that the Student Election Commission is hereby ENJOINED from placing the following names on the Spring 2005 ballot on the grounds that these candidates are not enrolled in the school for which they seek election to, in violation of Paragraph 1 of this Court's mandate:

- Jacob Clemens
- Celse Rodriguez

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Student Election Commission is hereby ENJOINED from placing on the following names on the Spring 2005 ballot on the grounds that these candidates failed to attend the mandatory pre-election candidate meeting and were not validly excused prior to that meeting, in violation of Paragraph 2 of this Court's mandate:

- Joshua Clemens
- Miguel Morga
- Eric Palm
- Celsa Rodriguez
- Jonathan Sauer
- Brandon Sivret
- Gabriela Varela
- Troy Vosseller
- Adam Witt

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, relief for any student from one category shall not constitute relief from other categories, unless said candidate demonstrates by clear and convincing evidence reason for such relief.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court shall continue to retain jurisdiction to issue further supplemental orders to this Order and the Court's original mandate.
